### Background and practical information

#### **CEDR CALL 2014 Asset Management and Maintenance**

Through CEDR Call 2014 Asset Management and Maintenance, CEDR members are currently funding research on key challenges for European road authorities including road equipment asset management, why and how to implement ISO 55000, social benefits and costs, use of standard raveling tests to predict pavement durability and recommendations for maintenance procurement by investigating current practices.

#### **ARISE Project**

The ARISE project will provide a practical guide for NRAs to implementing an ISO 55000 asset management system successfully, based on learning from both road and other sectors.

#### **Workshop Aim**

The ARISE consortium will explain the context of asset management and the principles of ISO55000, the experience of introducing ISO55000 in sectors such as rail and aviation and why and how to implement ISO55000 successfully into your organisation. While the primary audience is officials from European road authorities, the event organisers also encourage private contractors, consultants, professional bodies and universities to participate.

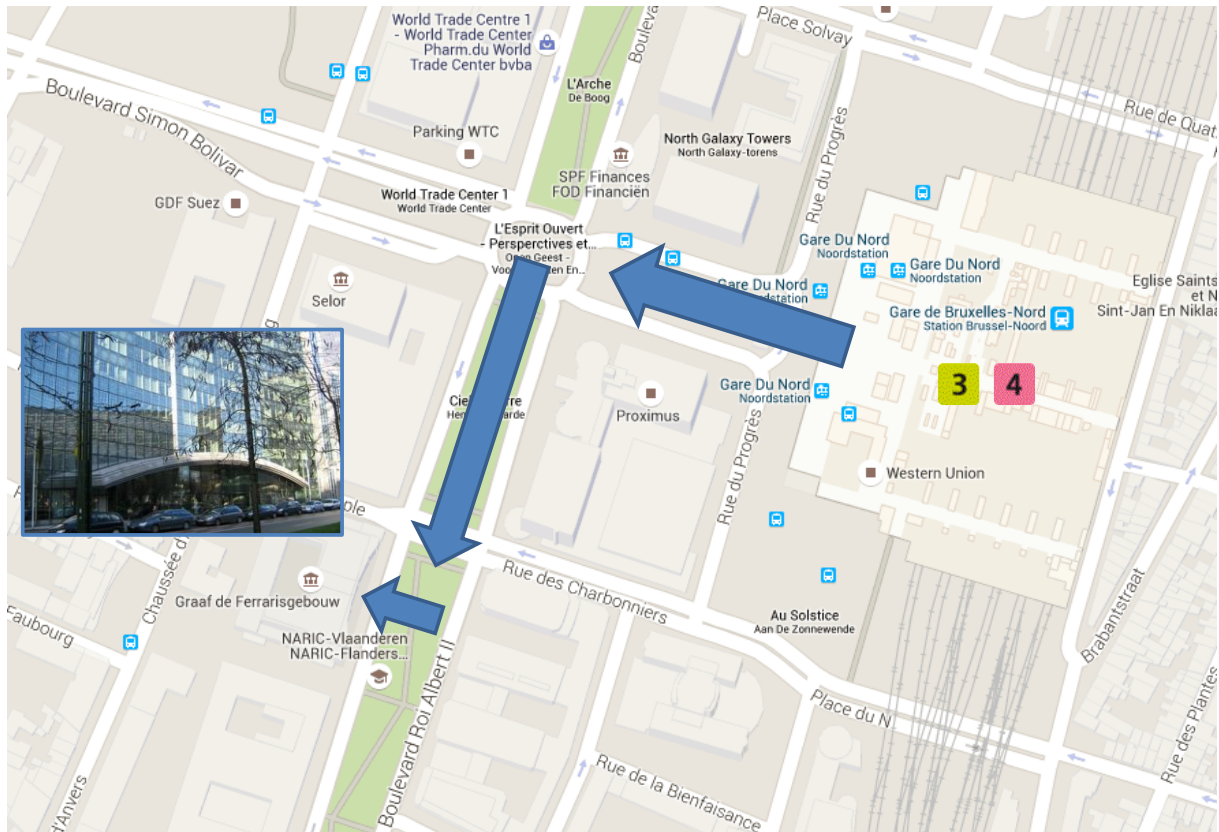
#### **Who should attend**

The workshop is intended for organisations that are on the journey towards implementing an Asset Management System, or have yet to start, whether or not they have yet decided to adopt a standard such as ISO55000. It will particularly help the following:

- **Policy Makers** will gain insight into why their organisation should consider adopting ISO55000 and the benefits
- **Managers** will be given clear guidance about what areas of the business may need to change, with helpful tips on actions they should be considering
- **Operations** staff will learn what general differences it will make to the way they go about maintaining their assets if the standard is adopted

The location of metro/tram line 3 and 4, which is in/under the train station "Bruxelles-Nord / Brussel-Noord" and goes to the city center (2 stops), is indicated on the map.

There is a direct train connection between Brussels Airport (train station is at level -1) and the train station "Bruxelles-Nord / Brussel-Noord" (and the two other main train stations, "Central" and "Midi"), which takes about 15 minutes (6 trains every hour). In the train station, make sure to take the west exit towards the "Boulevard Simon Bolivar" (the east exit goes into the red light district).
